

Using Practiscore to Register for a Match.

First you must set up an account.

Registering a New Account, if you do not have one.

1. Go to <https://practiscore.com/signup>

2. Enter:


A. Your email address

B. A password for Practiscore.

**NOT YOUR PASSWORD for

C. First & last name

D. Click the “Register” button

1. Select <Clubs>



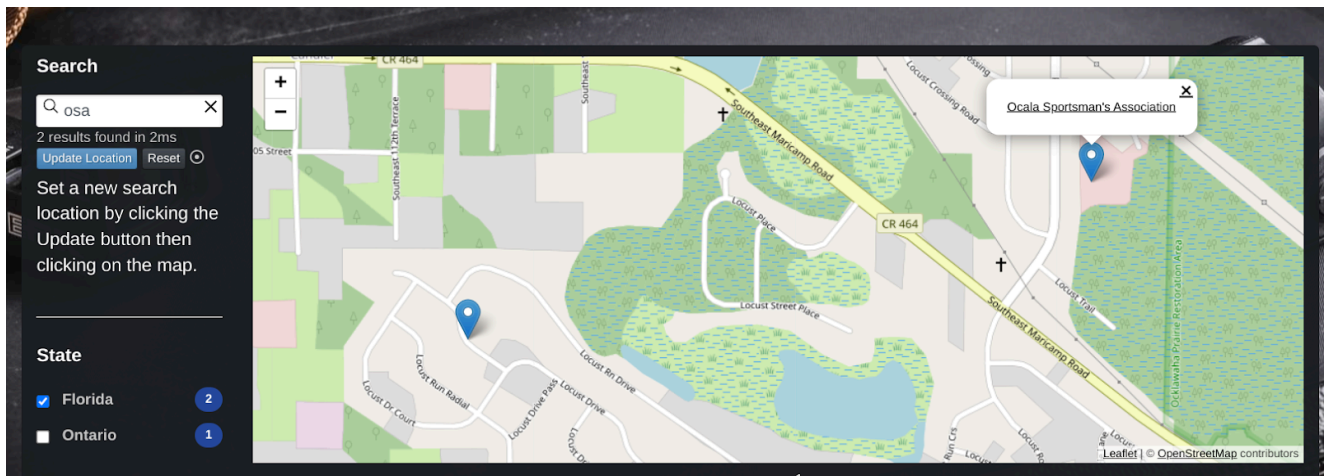
2. A map with a search feature opens.

3. For Search, key-in “OSA”

4. For State, select “Florida”

5. The map will zoom in, to show 2 locations.

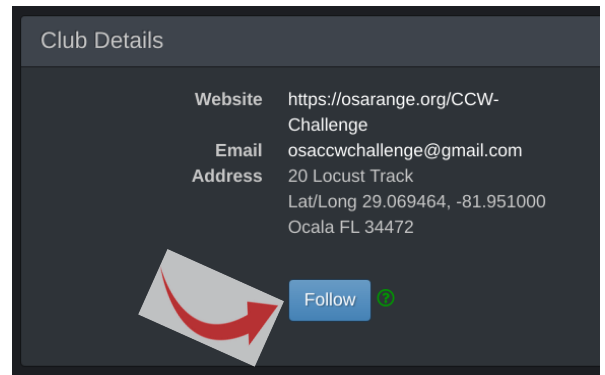
6. Click on the marker on the right

8. OSA “Club Details” will open.

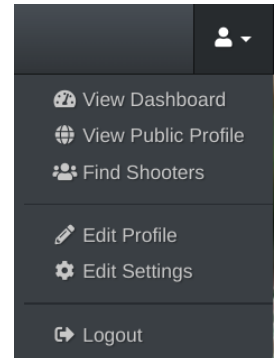
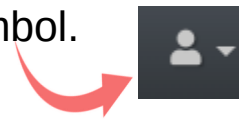
9. Click on the blue <Follow> square.

Your "Dashboard"

When you log-in, "Dashboard" is the first screen you will see. It's also a good place to start for whatever activity you are doing. If you move around the website & you want to go back to your "Dashboard" screen, follow these steps:

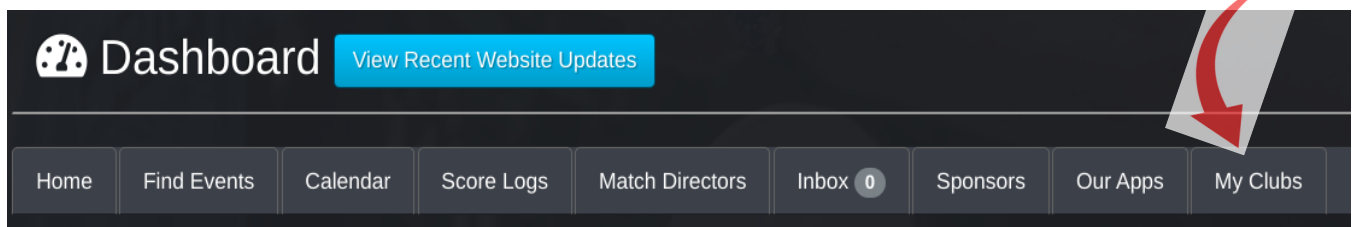
1. In the upper right corner click on the symbol.
2. A menu will drop down.
3. Select "View Dashboard"



How to see upcoming matches at OSA:

You need to go to the Ocala Sportsman's association web page in the Practiscore app.

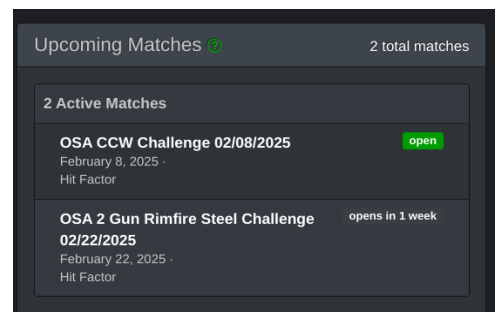
1. Start at your "Dashboard" page.
2. Select <My Clubs> from the "Dashboard" menu bar.



3. Select <Ocala Sportsman's Association> from "Clubs | Follow"

Register for a match:

1. Follow the steps to get to the Ocala Sportsman's Association web page in the Practiscore app.
2. In the "Upcoming Matches" section you will see the upcoming matches that you can register for.
3. Click on the match you want to register for & fill out the registration form.
4. Click the [Register] button. It will take you back to the review page.
5. Scroll down the review page until you see the squads.



6. Select the squad that you want to be on. The Admin will do his best to keep you on that squad, but at times adjustments have to be made.

Steps to See the matches you've registered for, Change the squad you are assigned to & steps to Withdraw from a match:

1. Start at your "Dashboard". Matches you have registered for will be listed under "Upcoming Events".

2. Click on the match you would like to see or change squads or withdraw from.
3. The "Match Info" page will open.

1. Scroll to the bottom of the page.
2. Select the squad you would like to move to.
3. Click on "Yes, Squad me!"
4. Click on "Select Squad"
